Summer COVID Procedures

Cedar Bay is looking forward to serving you this summer. As we communicate our COVID procedures we want each of our guests to feel comfortable at camp. We do not want this to be a divisive point at family camp as we look forward to building and renewing camp relationships.

Masking:

The CDC recommends that if you are vaccinated that you do not need to wear a mask indoors or outdoors. If you have not been vaccinated it is recommended that you wear a mask. Masks will be optional at camp this summer. If you feel that you should be wearing a mask, we encourage you to wear your mask. Cedar Bay trusts that each person will do what they feel most comfortable with.

Social Distancing:

We ask that all of us practice social distancing as appropriate while respecting others with differing view points than yourself.

- **Dining Procedures:**
 - Food will be served by our staff, rather than buffet style

- **Meetings:**
 - Chairs will be spaced throughout the meeting spaces according to the size of each camp to provide social distancing where possible
 - Children's programs will be outdoors as much as possible

- **Health Screening:**

Each family is required to complete a health screening form prior to arrival and turn it in at registration. Please do not come if you are exhibiting any COVID symptoms. One form for each family unit will suffice.

Please monitor your health throughout the week and if at any time during the week your health status changes please alert our staff AND be prepared to leave camp that same day.
