

Camp Pre-Arrival Info Guide

Summer 2026

What to Bring:

- Spending Money (or put money on your store card – see below)
- Bible/Pencil/Notebook
- Bedding for a twin-sized bed (or sleeping bag), pillow
- Towel/washcloth
- Swimsuits: Guys wear trunks, girls swimsuits should cover midriff - one piece or equivalent (we trust you to keep your private parts private)
- Toothbrush/toothpaste/shampoo/soap/deodorant
- Flashlight/insect repellent/sunscreen
- Camp clothes for 5 days:



Examples of Clothing to Bring:

- Athletic shorts/shirt
- Tennis Shoes
- Water Shoes/Sandals
- Long pants
- Dark clothes for night games
- Warmer layers, raincoat

Examples of Clothing to Leave at Home:

- Spandex, leggings
- Pants & shorts with rips above mid-thigh
- Short-shorts
- Muscle tanks/cut offs
- Shirts with inappropriate graphics/words



Drop Off/Pick Up

Sunday Drop Off:

- Registration is from 4:00-6:00 on Sunday afternoon
- Registration will start at the table in front of the main office
- Campers are encouraged to hang out near The Gathering Place once they get settled in their cabins— dinner will be served outside The Gathering Place from 5:00-6:45
- If you will be arriving later than 6:00pm, please contact camp at 715-689-2267
- Parents, you are encouraged to accompany your child through registration! During registration you will pay any remaining balance, fill out any necessary forms, assign someone who can pick your child up from camp, and add additional money on a store card.



Friday Pick up:

- You can pick up your child between 3:00-4:00 on Friday
- Our coffee shop and gift shop will be open during check-out time
- If you are arriving earlier or later than the designated check-out times, camp must be notified at 715-689-2267
- Individual campers can be picked up from his/her cabin. The person picking up your child must be on the “check-out” form and ready to show a photo I.D. Please call ahead if you need to add an authorized person to pick up your child from camp.



Store Accounts



Money can be added to your camper's store account online or during registration. These funds can be used to purchase items from any of our camp stores, and parents can track spending anytime through the registration portal. At the end of the week, any remaining balance under \$5 will automatically be donated to our camper scholarship fund, unless we are notified ahead of time that you would prefer a refund. Balances of \$5 or more will be refunded using the original payment method (electronically or by check).

Medications



By Wisconsin law, all medications must be turned in to the Nurse during registration in their **original packaging** (prescription or over-the-counter). Prescription drugs must be labeled with the camper's name, name of prescriber, name of prescription drug, the dose, the effective date, and the directions in a legible format. If the camper is a minor, a guardian must give written permission for the nurse to dispense medication.

Privacy & Protection of Campers

Gates Leading to camper cabins will be locked while camp is in session. Visitors must register at the office.

Wood Lake respects the privacy of all campers; however, the camp administration believes that order, safety, and the well-being of the whole comes before the privacy of the individual. Thus, Wood Lake reserves the right to search a camper's belongings if there is reasonable suspicion of inappropriate items such as, but not limited to – knives, guns, explosives (such as firecrackers), alcohol, stolen items, cigarettes, and/or drugs. If a camper's personal belongings are searched, there will be at least two staff members present in addition to the camper. One of the staff will be part of our administrative staff. If any illegal and/or inappropriate items are found, the items will be confiscated and held at the Camp Director's office. Immediate attempts will be made to contact the parents/guardians. Any additional action, other than confiscating the item, will depend on the situation. If the decision is made by Wood Lake's staff to contact law enforcement, a good faith effort will be made to contact the parents/guardians first.
